

UCHEALTH PARKVIEW FOUNDATION COMMUNITY HEALTH CARE SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW FALL 2026 / SPRING 2027

This program is designed to award health care scholarships to eligible students attending local institutions. The impact of this scholarship program is significant for sustaining a strong health care workforce in our community.

Candidate Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Pueblo County.
- Must be accepted in an accredited health care program at Colorado State University Pueblo, IntelliTec College - Pueblo, Pueblo Community College, or Otero College.
- Must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better (on a 4.0 scale).
- Must be available to participate in an in-person interview on June 23, 2026.
- Cannot be a current UCHealth Employee of 0.5 FTE or higher.

Application Requirements:

- Completed UCHealth Parkview Foundation Health Care Scholarship Application.
- A copy of nursing and/or healthcare program acceptance letter.
- One character-based letter of recommendation from your instructor, counselor, job supervisor or manager.
- Transcript (official or unofficial).
- Current resume.

Review and Selection Process:

A selection committee will review all applications and invite top candidates for an in-person interview by June 10, 2026. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. The in-person interviews will be held on June 23, 2026 at the UCHealth Parkview Foundation House - 325 W 15th Street, Pueblo, CO 81003. Following the interviews, the selection committee will select the scholarship award recipients. All applicants will be notified by July 1, 2026.

Deadline: To be considered, your application must be received by UCHealth Parkview Foundation (uchealthparkviewfoundation@uchealth.org) on or before **May 31, 2026.**

- Is my health care program eligible?
 - The UCHealth Parkview Foundation Community Health Care Scholarship is offered to undergraduate and graduate students at Colorado State University Pueblo, Intellitec Pueblo, Pueblo Community College and Otero College. The following fields of study are eligible: Physician Assistant/Nurse Practitioner, Bachelor of Science in Nursing, Registered Nursing, Certified Nursing Assistant, Respiratory Therapy, Surgical Technician, Radiography Technologist, Medical Lab Technician/Scientist, Radiation Therapy Technologist, Ultrasound Technologist/Diagnostic Sonographer, Occupational Therapy, Cardiac Sonography, Pathology, Medical Assistant.
 - If your field of study is not provided here, please email uhealthparkviewfoundation@uhealth.org for further assistance.
- Why are part-time and full-time UCHealth employees not eligible?
 - As an 0.5 or above FTE employee of UCHealth, you may be eligible to participate in the UCHealth Ascend Career Program.

- I cannot attend the in-person interview, is a virtual or over the phone interview available?
 - No, an in-person interview is a requirement to receive a scholarship award.
- I received a UCHealth Parkview Foundation scholarship in the past, can I apply?
 - Yes, you must reapply to be considered for subsequent years.
- What if I have not received acceptance into my desired health care program?
 - If you are awaiting acceptance to begin your health care program for Fall 2026, we encourage you to apply. Scholarship award recipients who are selected and awaiting formal acceptance will need to provide acceptance documentation prior to award payment.

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
